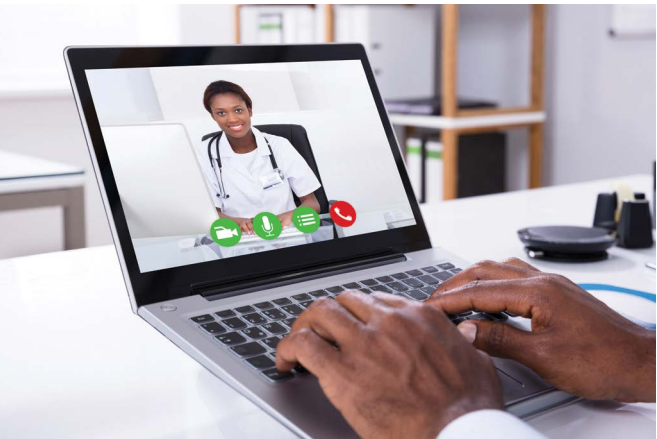


The U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs and Veterans service organizations (VSOs) are proud to connect Veterans with VA health care in their communities.

Veterans can meet with a VA provider by video in a private appointment room at select local VSOs, including American Legion posts and Veterans of Foreign Wars (VFW) Posts. This option can benefit Veterans with long travel times to VA health care facilities or limited connectivity at home.



Video Telehealth Services at VSOs



VSO locations provide Veterans with a **private appointment room** to virtually meet with a VA provider.



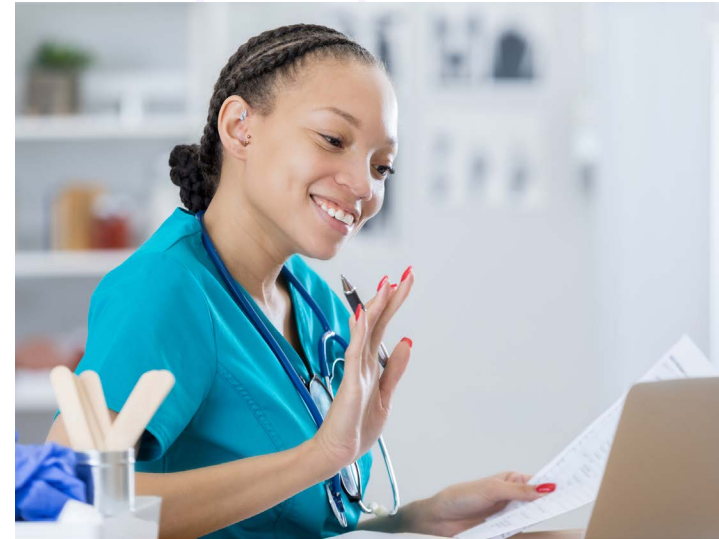
Appointment rooms are **equipped with internet access and the technology** needed for a telehealth visit.



Using the VA Video Connect app, Veterans can connect with a VA provider through **secure, real-time video**.



An **on-site attendant** is available at ATLAS sites to assist Veterans with using telehealth equipment.



VA Clinical Services at VSOs

ATLAS (Accessing Telehealth through Local Area Stations) sites **offer health care services that don't require hands-on exams**. These services may include, but are not limited to, primary care, mental health counseling, clinical pharmacy services, nutrition services, and social work.
